## SSO - Cannot authenticate with credentials

## **Problem**

You cannot use the same credentials used on <a href="www.kiuwan.com">www.kiuwan.com</a> to authenticate using some of the Single-Sign-On authentication methods.

## Solution

If you are using HTTP authentication or form-based authentication, you have to configure your username and password you use to authenticate against your organization's identity provider, not the credentials you use in <a href="https://www.kiuwan.com">www.kiuwan.com</a>.

If your IDP is ADFS, usually the username is composed by the ID you use to log into the organization's domain network, plus '@' and the domain name.

I.e., if you use the id: 'john' to log into your Windows machine and the domain to log into is 'contoso.com', then your username for ADFS is: 'john@contoso.com'.
